## Camp Registration

Register your child by calling or visiting the shop. Payment in full is due at the time of registration.

### Junior Campers

Children ages 5 to 7. Junior Camps are Tuesdays through Thursdays 10 am to 2 pm. Cost is \$225 for each three-day camp.



### Senior Campers

Children ages 8 and up. Camps are Mondays through Thursdays 10 am to 2 pm. Cost is \$295 for each four-day camp.

### Youth Campers

Older kids ages 10 and up. Camps are Mondays through Thursdays 10 am to 2 pm. Cost is \$295 for each four-day camp.

### What to Bring



Please pack a lunch and water bottle for your child each day of camp. Play clothes and comfortable shoes should be worn.

There will be a release form for parents/guardians to complete and sign. These forms will be emailed ahead of time; copies will also be available on the first morning of each camp session. Campers will bring all their projects home on the last day of camp.

### Cancellation Policy

Cancellations made more than 7 days before the start of each camp will receive a full refund or credit towards another camp.

Cancellations made 5-7 days before the start of each camp will receive a 50% refund or 50% credit towards another camp.

Cancellations made 4 days or less before the start of each camp will not receive a refund or credit, except in cases of illness.

If we must cancel a camp, a full refund will be issued.

### Sick Policy

If your child is feeling sick, please keep them home. We will issue a refund or credit for the day(s) your child is unable to attend.
